- **THEORIES AND METHODS COMPONENT** **(6-7 Units)**

*For TUNE students ONLY: PSYC 314 may be taken in place of ANTH 380, ANTH 382, CRMJ 368, CRMJ 370, SOCI 300 or SOCI 391. Note that PSYC 314 requires a prerequisite of PSYC 212.*

- **UPPER LEVEL REQUIRED AREAS** **(15 units)**

*Students select and complete a total of six courses: three courses from one area, two courses from a second area, and one course from a third area depending on interest and learning goals. See catalog for choices.*

  - **Social Control: Reactions to Crime (Do Not Choose CRMJ 356 – see note)**
  - **Criminology: Nature of Crime**
  - **Criminal Justice Practice**

Note: CJ 103 (CRMJ T56/356) satisfies this area. Do not take more than two additional courses in Social Control: Reactions to Crime.

- **SOCIOLOGY/ANTHROPOLOGY/ OUTSIDE ELECTIVES (Do Not Choose SOCI 249 or PHIL 253) (0-3 units)**

*Students who do not complete SOC 201 at HCC will need to take a course with a SOCI or ANTH designation at TU to satisfy this area.*
