*Students should choose MATH 216 as Mathematics General Education elective. MATH 216 is the recommended course to satisfy the required lower level math program prerequisite at TU. (MATH 109, 111, 203, 204, 212 will also satisfy the requirement.)

**GH electives must be chosen from two different disciplines.

***Students should choose BIO 100 as Biological Lab Science elective to satisfy a required lower level program prerequisite. Students who do not take BIO 100 must take BIOL 120/120L at TU.

TUNE students may need to take this course at TU's main campus.

****Choose one of the following: ENG 205, ENG 206, HIST 103, HIST 104, HLTH 101, HLTH 103, MUS 223, PL 101, PS 101, PS 102, PS 106, PS 204, THEA 101

*****Requires Course Directive for Core placement.

Note: Students should choose PSY 214 as a psychology program elective to satisfy required course at TU. Students who do not take PSY 214 must take PSYC 203 at TU. TUNE students may need to take this course at TU's main campus. Also, it is recommended that students take PSY 204 (Abnormal Psychology) as a psychology program elective before transferring to TU. Note that the equivalent to PSY 204 (PSYC 361) is not offered at the TUNE campus.
