

The following outlines course requirements for Harford Community College's RN to Towson University's BS with a major in Nursing program. The top portion of the chart indicates the courses required for the A.S. degree in nursing from Harford Community College and the course equivalency at the transfer institution. The lower portion of the chart reflects additional prerequisite requirements at the receiving institution and the HCC course equivalency. This chart is intended to show only the basic course requirements for the major and does not include the nursing courses required for the A.S. degree in nursing from HCC or the upper-level degree requirements of the receiving institution. Be sure to contact the four-year institution for additional admission requirements.

\*\*\*MATH 216 is strongly recommended to satisfy both HCC's GM requirements and TU's prerequisite for NURS 435 Research. Students who do not complete MATH 216 at HCC will have to satisfy this requirement at TU, raising the additional prerequisites requirements for the major from seven (7) credits to ten (10) credits.

**More on the RN to BS with a major in Nursing at Towson University:**

The total number of credits, in addition to HCC requirements for the RN degree, which must be completed at Towson University is seven (7) credits. While a statistics course is not a prerequisite requirement for admission to the program it is a prerequisite for NURS 435 Research. Thirty (30) upper level nursing credits are to be completed at Towson University. Students must apply and be admitted to both the Undergraduate Admissions Office and the Department of Nursing at Towson University. A minimum GPA of 2.5 and a proficient TEAS V score is required for admission to the university's nursing program.
