

The following outlines course requirements for the RN to BSN program at the University of Maryland School of Nursing. The top portion of the chart indicates the courses required for the A.S. degree in nursing from Harford Community College and the course equivalency at the receiving institution. The lower portion of the chart reflects additional prerequisite requirements at the receiving institution and the HCC course equivalency. This chart is intended to show only the basic course requirements for the major and does not include the nursing courses required for the A.S. degree in nursing from HCC or the upper-level degree requirements of the receiving institution. Be sure to contact the four-year institution for additional admission requirements.

More on the RN to BSN at the University of Maryland, Baltimore:

Twenty-seven (27) credits, in addition to HCC requirements for the RN degree, must be completed prior to admission to the University of Maryland School of Nursing. The minimum overall GPA for admission to the program is 3.0. A science GPA of 3.0 is also required for acceptance (this includes Chemistry, Anatomy and Physiology I and II, Microbiology). Thirty-one (31) upper-level nursing credits are to be completed at the University of Maryland, Baltimore.
