**YORK COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS**

**1. COMMON CORE (3 credits)** All courses must be completed with a minimum “2.0” grade.

Courses may not be taken on a pass/fail basis.

**2. AREA DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS (9 credits)**

**ADR-I through V:** A minimum of 12 credits of the Area Distribution Requirements must be at the 200-level or above. Courses may not be taken on a pass/fail basis. See Registrar's Office for official list of courses. (HCC students who follow the articulation worksheet will automatically meet this requirement)

**\*ADR-V** Six credits are to be taken in one of these two areas; if foreign language is selected, six credits must be in one language.

### 3. ELECTIVE COURSES: (3-5 credits)

Twelve of these elective credits must be taken outside of the Dept. of Business Administration. The remaining electives may be used to complete a minor. Internships and Independent Studies will be considered within these elective areas but not towards required 400-level coursework.

#### b. Additional Business Courses: (24 credits)

Required: Select at least 1 but no more than 2 electives from each area and at least 6 credits of 400-level electives (including International Bus Elect).

Accounting: ACC305, ACC315, ACC320, ACC375  
Economics: ECO350, ECO360, ECO390  
Finance: FIN320, FIN330, FIN340  
Management: OBD225, OBD280, MGT220, MGT445, SCM455  
Marketing: MKT350, MKT360, MKT380, MKT410

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#### IT Competency:

All business students must establish Information Technology (IT) competency by passing an IT Competency Exam or by completing IFS105 Personal Productivity Computing with a "2.0" or better within the first 30-credits completed at York College.

A cumulative grade point average of "2.0" or better is required in the General Business Component courses. At least four 300-400 level Business courses must be taken at York College.

Any course that is a prerequisite course must be passed with at least a "2.0" before its post-requisite course may be attempted. A student who has received less than a "2.0" in any pre-requisite business administration course will be permitted to repeat the course a maximum of two additional times (three total attempts). Withdrawing from a course does not count in the "attempts" total.
