

WORLD CLASS ARENA

The focal point of the newly renovated Susquehanna Center is the state-of-the-art APG Federal Credit Union Arena, the largest indoor venue in Northeastern Maryland. The arena serves as the home of Harford's Fighting Owls basketball and volleyball teams and is available for a wide range of other events for the campus and community to enjoy.
