The polka originated in Eastern Bohemia as a simplified version of a waltz. As its popularity spread throughout Europe and the US, both the dance and the music that accompanied it took on regional variations. **Polkadelfia** introduces you to the "oompah" version best known for its tuba, trombone, trumpet and accordion, and a raucous good time!



Drawing from Japan's rich tradition of music and performance, **Taikoza** blends traditional Taiko drums, bamboo flutes and the Koto (a stringed instrument) to create a sound that transcends national boundaries. Formed in New York in 1995, Taikoza brings new energy to this ancestral form.
