

Exemptions for Placement Tests

Students with qualifying scores in SAT, ACT, PARCC, Accuplacer, GED, AP or IB tests give students a College and Career Readiness designation. Official copy of qualifying scores in all tests should be sent to Admissions for review and consideration.

NOTE: Students needing college algebra or pre-calculus or above for program of study must take the Accuplacer™ test or the advanced math readiness test. Use the [Math Placement Guidance Information](#) to determine if there are other assessments you may have taken and that can be used for math placement.
