

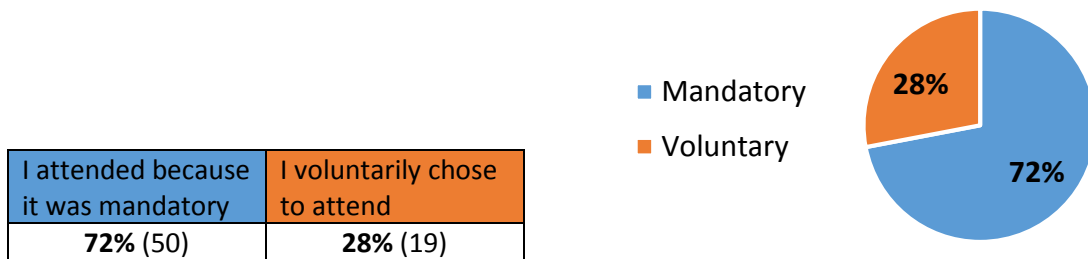
Student Survey regarding 2017 Nursing Student Leadership Workshop

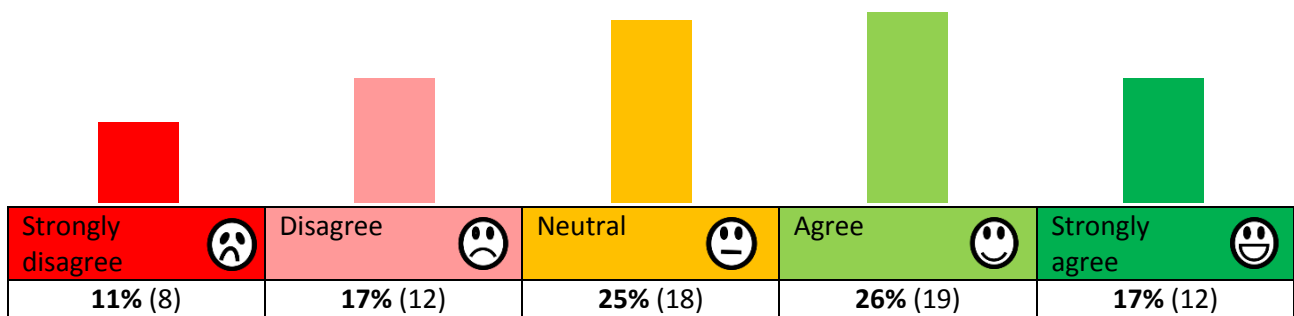

Survey respondents = 69 total responses.

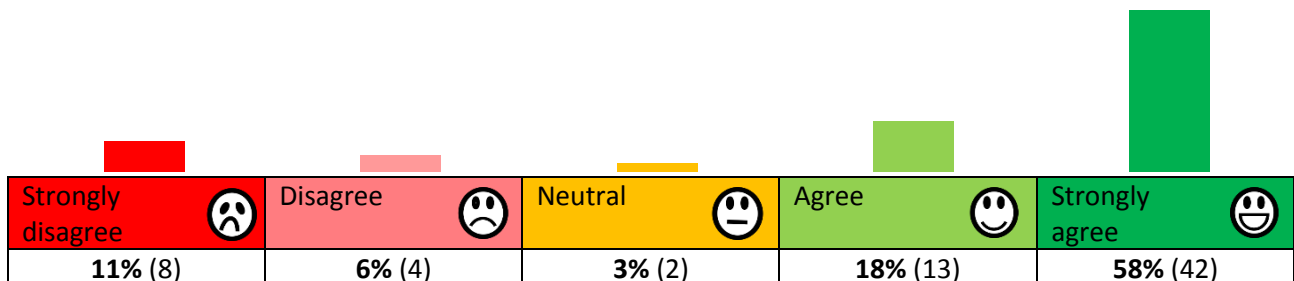
Question #1: Please indicate your reason for attending the Nursing Student Leadership Workshop.



Question #2: I would have attended the Nursing Student Leadership Workshop even if I did not go with my school.

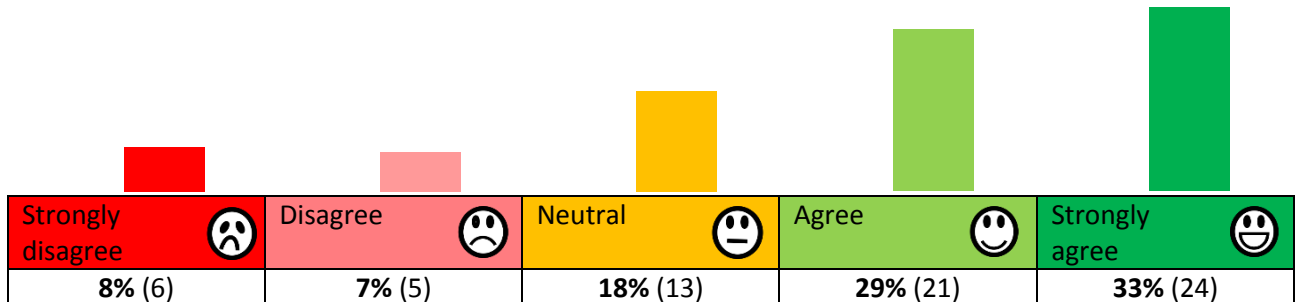


Question #3: I am grateful that I had the opportunity to attend the Nursing Student Leadership Workshop as a student.

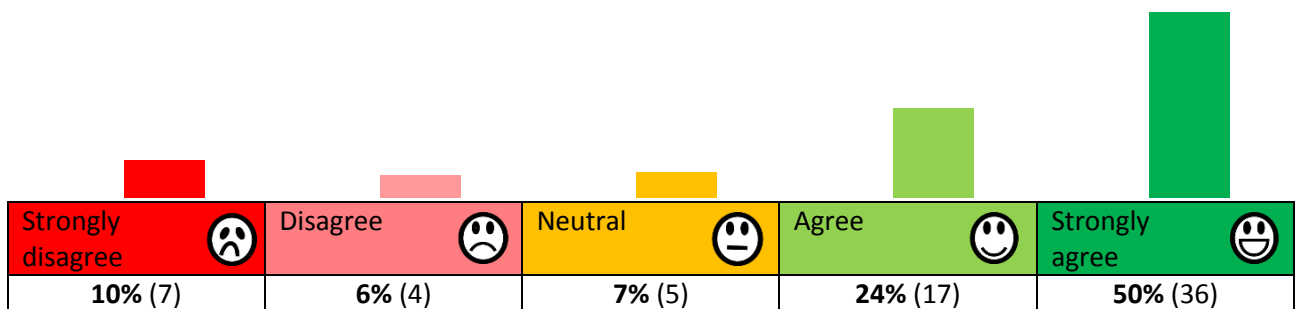

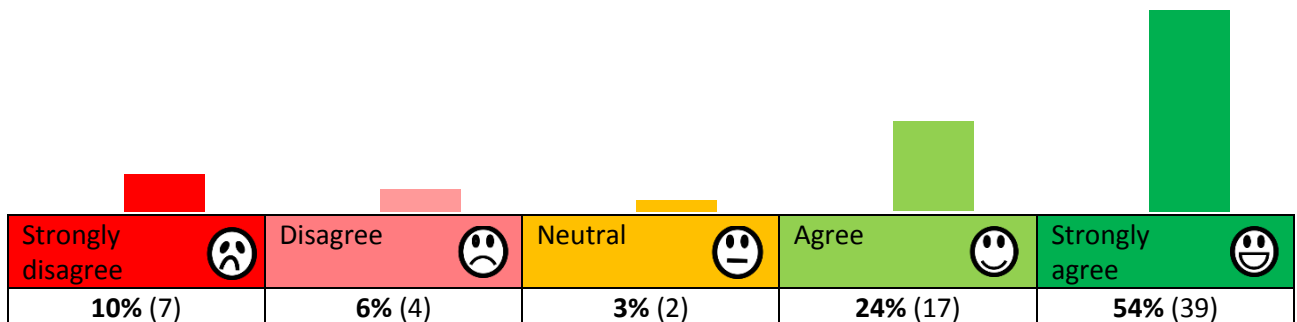
Question #4: I would like to attend the Nursing Student Leadership Workshop in the future.



Question #6: I have a greater understanding of current issues that are relevant to nursing practice.

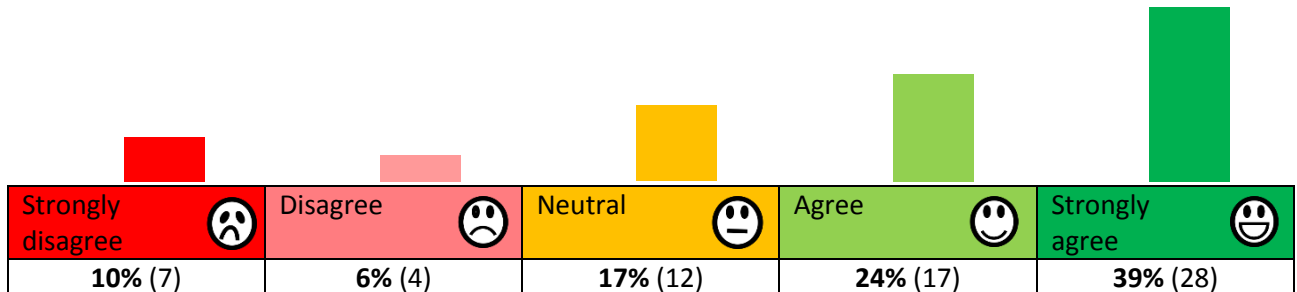


Question #7: The convention increased my understanding of professional development in nursing.

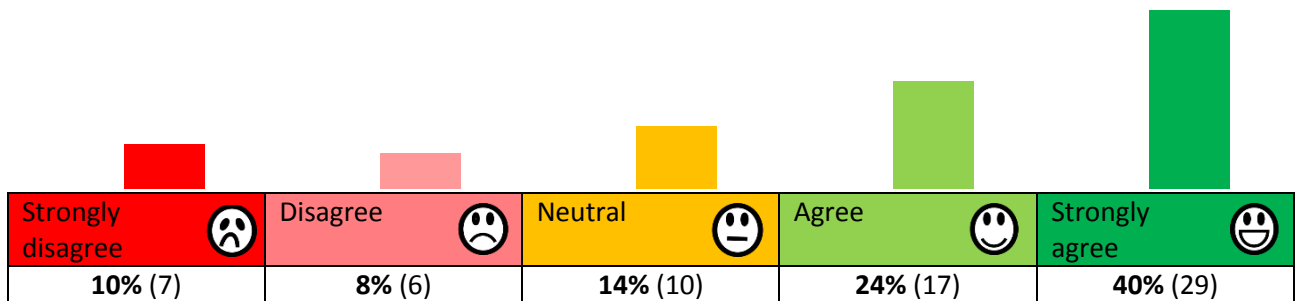

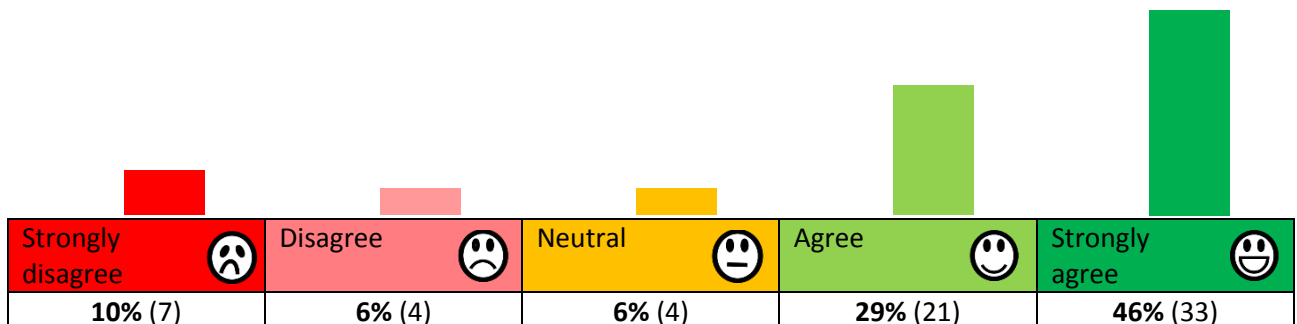
Question #8: I was able to network with experienced nursing professionals.



Question #9: I was able to network with potential employers.

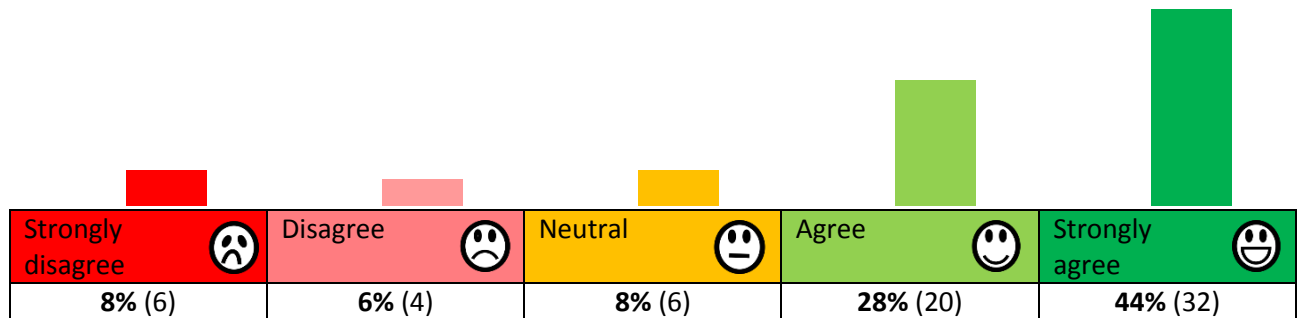


Question #10: I was able to network with representatives from various universities.
