

**Harford Community College
Nursing Program Selection Criteria
effective Summer/Fall 2017 admission cycle**

Students are encouraged to meet with an academic advisor as soon as they become interested in applying to the Nursing Program for assistance with selecting a plan of study and course selection. The Nursing Program is highly competitive and completion of the admission criteria may not result in admission to the Program. Courses must be completed and TEAS Test scores received by the application deadline for consideration for admission.

Once all of the application requirements have been met, admission to the Nursing Program is based on the following criteria:
