



Presidential Search Committee Update

August 13, 2020

The presidential search committee met on July 23 and received some preliminary information regarding the candidate pool. The committee also reviewed drafts of the interview formats and questions, and formed an ad hoc committee to further develop the interview questions.

The Board has discussed and come to consensus on an appropriate salary range for the position.

On August 12, the committee reconvened to narrow down the pool of candidates who will be invited to participate in first-round interviews.

Mr. Payne and Mr. Linkous express their gratitude to the search committee members for their hard work and extensive efforts: In only a few short weeks, this group carefully reviewed more than 40 applications, and narrowed that pool to 11 first-round candidates.
